





The Challenge

Some of DSD's Security Considerations

- My data or functionality to be moved to the cloud is not business critical
- I will maintain an up to date backup copy of my data
- When I delete my data, the storage media is sanitised before being reused
- Storage media storing sensitive data can be adequately sanitised
- My data is not too sensitive to store or process in the cloud

- Does the cloud solution offer more benefits vs risks compared to the in house solution?
- Does the cloud solution comply with regulatory & legislative requirements?
- Does the cloud solution provide better security controls than in the in house solution?
- Is the business satisfied with the SLA?

Lessons Learnt
