

Estimated Net Marginal Cost by Platform






Costs

 - 100/40 Mbps, 1 Tbyte, \$165 p.m. per service*
 - 100/40 Mbps, 375 Tbyte, \$62k p.m. x2 per link?**



What does this mean?

- The NBN is a distribution network providing between 350 kbps and 10 Mbps of uncontended throughput between each user and a local Pol
- The cost per user will be determined by the amount of traffic contracted, at the moment only internet type traffic is defined, not private network traffic required for high volume use
- Backhaul from the Pol to the service providers target network is not the responsibility of the NBN



What backhaul options are available at the Pol?


- Telstra

- Private microwave (or fibre!)




Example Network

Take Home Message

- There is no magic in the NBN, it is an effective distribution mechanism for internet, but probably not for private network traffic
