

To provide a safe campus you must -


- -be aware of the event ASAP

- -and deliver a unified message to both personal and campus devices.






















Alcatel-Lucent Solution components for Campus Safety

It could have been another one of those tragedies that we see all too often on the news - a mass shooting on a college campus. However, on February 19, at Santa Fe Community College (SFCC) in Gainesville, Florida, tragedy was avoided.

There was a man with a gun on campus that day, but no shots were fired and no one was hurt.
